Executes installations of kitchen equipment per plan/guidelines for new store and remodel projects. Will assist with the planning and scheduling of projects, oversee equipment unloading, installation and inventory of equipment. Additional duties as outlined below.

- Be familiar with the scope of work and list of responsibilities for each job.
- Manage overall day to day activities for all assigned projects.
- Inspect jobsite for readiness and coordinate corrections as needed.
- Ability to make decisions independently on installation & related items
- Ability to maintain detailed project records.
- Ability to manage multiple projects simultaneously.
- Secure proper labor and tools to safely unload equipment into store. This may involve the lifting of heavy equipment in adverse field conditions.
- Inspect all delivered equipment and report any damage according to company policy.
- Set, assemble, affix and weld equipment as required.
- Assemble walk-in cooler freezer boxes.
- When possible, direct/assist local start-up agencies in setup and start-up of specific OEM equipment.
- Perform basic operational checks of equipment as required, to include applying power.
- Assist with all required inspections by working closely with local authority holding jurisdiction (AHJ).
- Arrange for packaging and transportation of damaged goods or goods to be returned prior to departure.
- Coordinate Installations with local sub-contractors, installers and start-up agencies (new and remodels).
- Conduct walk thru inventories with owner operators or their appointed representatives.
- Ensure that all post installation documentation is completed and submitted as required.
- Escalate any issues that impact safety, scheduled completion or cost of installation.
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duties satisfactorily. 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Education and Experience

Two to five years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Associate's degree (A. A.) or equivalent from two-year College or technical school a plus. Welding Certification

Language Ability:

Ability to read, analyze, and interpret general business periodicals, professional journals, technical procedures, or governmental regulations. Welding and forklift operation certifications a plus.

Supervisory Responsibilities:

Will at times supervise other H&K and contracted employees. Coordinate with electricians, plumbers and General Contractor trades. Responsible for the safe conduct of work in a construction environment.



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Work Environment:

General construction site conditions, temp power and water, no heat and air, uneven surfaces and moderate noise level. Conditions can vary greatly from site to site. At other times work will be conducted in an operational commercial kitchen setting.
