Summary

The Warehouse Worker performs all tasks that assist in the overall operation of the warehouse. This includes but is not limited to shipping and receiving goods, order pulling and assembly, operating a lift truck, and similar tasks. Classifications are determined by management of H&K and are based on experience, skill and ability.

Essential Functions

- Assists in all areas of warehouse including shipping, receiving, and crating.
- Ensures that received goods are processed in a timely manner and moved to the correct location within the warehouse.
- Pulls and packages customer orders in a timely and accurate manner.
- Performs various transactions and enters data into the computer system as assigned.
- Notifies supervisor if goods are damaged or if overages/shortages are discovered.
- Works closely with other departments to gather the necessary information that will allow the timely receipt of all deliveries.
- Adheres to company safety guidelines and follows personal protective equipment policies.
- Responsible for the safe loading/unloading of trucks by driving a sit-down forklift.
- Performs other duties throughout warehouse as assigned.

Education, Experience, and Knowledge Requirements

The ideal candidate will have a High school diploma or general education degree (GED), a minimum of 1 year of general warehouse experience, knowledge of basic computer functioning, and an understanding of basic math. An ability to receive direction and work with others to accomplish a collective goal is required.
